NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham in exercise of its powers under Sections 6 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter called "the Act") and all other enabling legislation and powers and after consultation with the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis in accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act made the above Order, the effect of which will be to continue indefinitely provisions of the experimental traffic order listed in the heading to this Notice, which by way of an experiment;

The general effect of the Order will be to:

1. Introduce a prohibition of Right Turn restriction during the hours of 8.00am to 10.00am and 4.30pm to 7.00pm, Monday to Saturday from Reede Road eastbound lane into the private access for the car park area of Lidl / Iceland on the south side of Reede Road 38 metres east of its junction with Heathway.

A copy of the Order, which will come into force on 20 November 2023, and the Council's Statement of Reasons for making the Order are available to view for a period of 6 weeks from the date on which this notice is published on the Councils website by visiting the following web page https://www.lbbd.gov.uk/parking/parking-area and selecting 'New and proposed traffic and parking schemes' or available for inspection at the Adult Library, First Floor, Barking Learning Centre, Barking between the hours of 9.00am and 4.00pm Monday to Friday.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that they are not within the powers of the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or any Regulations under it have not been complied with may do so within six weeks of the made date of the Order by applying to the High Court.
