THE LONDON BOROUGH OF BARKING AND DAGENHAM (WAITING, LOADING AND PAYMENT PARKING RESTRICTIONS) (ST PAUL'S ROAD) AMENDMENT No. 125 ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham in exercise of its powers under sections 6, 124 and Parts I to IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter called "the Act") and all other enabling legislation and powers and after consultation with the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis in accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act made the above Order, the effect of which will be to:

- 1. Introduce Goods vehicles loading only 6am-9pm 30mins No return within 2hrs restrictions at the following locations:
 - a. St Paul's Road, south-east side, from a point 37.9 metres south-west of its junction with the St Paul's Road and Gascoigne Road roundabout for a distance of 25.9 metres in a south-westerly direction.
 - b. St Paul's Road, south-east side, from a point 83 metres south-west of its junction with the St Paul's Road and Gascoigne Road roundabout for a distance of 18 metres in a south-westerly direction.
 - Revoke No waiting at any time restrictions at the following locations:
 - a. St Paul's Road, south-east side, from a point 114.6 metres north-east of its junction with Abbey Road for a distance of 5.2 metres in a north-easterly direction.
 - b. St Paul's Road, south-east side, from a point 37.9 metres south-west of its junction with the St Paul's Road and Gascoigne Road roundabout for a distance of 25.9 metres in a south-westerly direction.
- 3. Revoke Payment Parking (TC1) 6am-9pm Max stay 4hrs No return within 2hrs restrictions at the following locations:
 - a. St Paul's Road, south-east side, from a point 102.8 metres north-east of its junction with Abbey Road for a distance of 11.6 metres in a north-easterly direction.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that they are not within the powers of the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or any Regulations under it have not been complied with may do so within six weeks of the made date of the Order by applying to the High Court.
