THE LONDON BOROUGH OF BARKING AND DAGENHAM (WAITING AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS) (TANNER STREET, BARKING) AMENDMENT No. 126 ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham in exercise of its powers under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 and Parts I to IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter called "the Act") and all other enabling legislation and powers and after consultation with the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis in accordance with Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act made the above Order, the effect of which will be to:

1. Relocate the existing Resident Permit Holders Only Zone WB Mon-Fri 8.30am-5.30pm bays from fully on the carriageway to 2 wheel parking on Rusholme Avenue, north side, outside Nos. 2-12 Rusholme Avenue.
2. Replace the No waiting Mon-Fri 8.30am-5.30pm restrictions with No Waiting at any time restrictions on Tanner Street, south-east side, from a point 13 metres south-west of its junction with Fanshawe Avenue for 17.8 metres in a south-westerly direction.
3. Replace the existing Resident Permit Holders Only Zone G Mon-Fri 8.30am-5.30pm bay with No waiting Mon-Fri 8.30am-5.30pm restrictions on Tanner Street, south-east side, outside No. 76-78 Tanner Street.

A copy of the Orders, which will come into force on Monday 3 June 2024 and the Council's Statement of Reasons for making the Orders are available to view for a period of 6 weeks from the date on which this notice is published on the Council's website by visiting the following webpage <https://www.lbld.gov.uk/parking/parking-area> and selecting 'New and proposed traffic and parking schemes' or available for inspection at the Adult Library, First Floor, Barking Learning Centre, Barking between the hours of 9.00am and 4.00pm Monday to Friday.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that they are not within the powers of the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or any Regulations under it have not been complied with may do so within six weeks of the made date of the Order by applying to the High Court.
